Advent: This Sunday, we mark the beginning of the Church year with the season of Advent. Advent focuses Christians on the coming of Christ and the Church understands the coming of Christ as a three-fold process: Christ, the Son of God, came on earth long ago, as the scriptures tell us, to reveal God's love for us. We believe also, as we say each Sunday in the creed, that Christ will come again at the end of time to judge the living and the dead. In the meantime, he will come into our lives, if we invite him, and make his home in our hearts. The weeks of Advent then, are a time for opening our hearts to Christ, inviting him into our lives so that we may be ready to welcome him when he comes again and also be prepared to celebrate his first coming among us as a child in Bethlehem at Christmas. To help mark the season of Advent, at the back of the church this weekend you will find a candle and a prayer card. Each household is invited to bring home a candle and card and take time to pray the prayer for each day of the week as well as the prayer for the World Meeting of Families on the front of the card over the weeks of Advent. Hopefully that will help us prepare our hearts to truly celebrate Christmas.

**Blessing of figures of Baby Jesus:** Have you a crib in your home for Christmas? If so, you are invited to bring the figure of the Baby Jesus from your crib to be blessed during Mass on the Third Sunday of Advent (December 17<sup>th</sup>). Anyone in the household may bring the figure of the Baby Jesus forward for the blessing-perhaps the children might like to do so. This is an old Italian custom which has been suggested to parishes here this year by the Irish Grandparents Association.
